

HASKETON PARISH COUNCIL

DATA PROTECTION STATEMENT

Section 7(3) of the Data Protection Act (DPA) 2018 states that Parish Councils are not public authorities for the purposes of the GDPR, therefore Hasketon Parish Council is not required to appoint a Data Protection Officer. However, it is required to comply in other respects with the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018. Details of how Hasketon Parish Council has complied with the legislation can be found on the Hasketon Parish Council website Parish Council, <https://hasketonparishcouncil.gov.uk/> under the heading Parish Council information.

The legislation is aimed at protecting individual's rights regarding the sort of personal information held by organisations and what they can do with that information. Individuals have the right to see any personal data held by the Parish Council (there are some exceptions) and can request to have it removed or amended if incorrect. This should be done in writing, email or on the appropriate form (Subject Access Request application form) and submitted to the Parish Clerk. At the address below.
